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## 2021 Parent Payments

Dear Parents/Guardian,

Rollins Primary School is looking forward to another great year of teaching and learning and would like to advise you of our parent payment arrangements for 2021. The Department of Education has changed the way schools calculate and request the fees to the school community, with these changes the school can only charge families for Essential Student Learning items, (these must be items individual students consume/take possession of). Each year level has a different charge depending on the requirements for 2021.

A voluntary fee has been introduced, which will assist our school with the purchase of items for general use within the classroom. To view the Parent Payment Agreement, please visit the website <https://www2.education.vic.gov.au/pal/parent-payment/guidance>.

Rollins Primary School makes every effort to keep the cost of items and activities to a minimum and affordable for all parents.

This year School council has endorsed the payment of fees on Compass, an explanation of each fee is available by clicking on the links in Compass. The fee schedule for 2021 is also available for your child's year level on our school website

Payments via Compass can be made in full by Friday 11/12/2020 or by instalment which will be deducted in three equal payments. First instalment will be deducted on Friday 11/12/2020. **Your credit card will automatically be charged** for the future instalments on Friday 5/2/2021 and Friday 12/03/2021. **This will allow for book packs to be in the classroom ready for the first day of school.**

Families should be aware the school is a registered "Centrepay Service Provider". This means that Parents/Guardian in receipt of a Centrelink payment can pay their child's education costs by having an amount deducted from their Centrelink payment and paid directly to the school fortnightly. Parents can nominate the amount they would like to pay. The school will then use this payment to offset the amount due for Essential Student Learning Items.

CentrePay – Regular deduction from family tax benefit via Centrelink

Local Community Supports such as Bethany and St Vincent De Paul may also assist.
